E. Roofer Program Status (MA 1050, 3021, 8012)

MA 1050 has taken action to register all MA 3021 apprentices and training agents interested in continuing their training. The Division plans to report at the March 2011 subcommittee meeting that MA 3021 can be dissolved since all apprentices will be properly transferred, completed or terminated by that time.

Revised standards and ratio/related training reports have not been submitted by MA 1050 as requested by the Council and no committee representative was available to respond to subcommittee questions.
