The Washington State Apprenticeship and Training Council approved the revised reciprocal agreement in April 2011. Montana has already agreed to the proposed changes. The Rules and Policy Subcommittee has taken action to recommend approval of the revised agreement.

Permanent rulemaking regarding the elimination of the temporary electrical apprentice license is moving forward for permanent rulemaking. A public hearing is scheduled June 21, 2011.

OSATC Policy 16 will be redrafted for review at the next Rules and Policy Subcommittee meeting.
