NOTE: A nonrefundable application fee of \$25 will be charged. Individuals with incomes below 150% of the federal poverty guidelines may apply for a fee waiver.

Applications must be completed and returned within 45 days of initial application.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Age: Must be at least eighteen [18] years old.
2. Education: Must be a high school graduate or have a GED, or, in lieu of a high school diploma or a GED, have a two year Associate Degree or higher. Must provide an **OFFICIAL** transcript for high school [year or years completed] and post high school training. All GED records must be submitted if applicable.
3. Minimum math:
 - a. One full year of high school algebra with a passing grade of "C" or better, or
 - b. One post high school algebra course with a passing grade of "C" or better, or
 - c. Placement test for Math 65 or better.
4. Must obtain a qualifying score on the electrical trade's aptitude test developed and validated by the American Institutes for Research.

GEOGRAPHICAL AREA: JACKSON, JOSEPHINE, KLAMATH, LAKE, HARNEY, and DOUGLAS COUNTY EAST OF THE COASTAL WATERSHED DIVIDE AREA IN OREGON AND SISKIYOU AND MODOC COUNTIES IN CALIFORNIA.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age-except the applicant must be at least 17 years of age to apply and 18 years of age at time of indenture. The JATC does not, and will not, discriminate against a qualified individual with a disability because of the disability of such individual. The sponsor will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in apprenticeship and will operate the apprenticeship program as required under applicable law and lawful regulations issued hereunder.

Applicants who meet all basic requirements will be interviewed by the JATC. Apprentices will be selected in order of their final ranking as jobs become available.
