RULE CAPTION

Implementing amendments to procedures for complaints of discriminatory practice to require signature by aggrieved party.

Not more than 15 words that reasonably identifies the subject matter of the agency's intended action.

RULE SUMMARY

The proposed rules would amend the rules implementing complaint procedures for civil rights violations to include newly enacted requirements that a verified written complaint is valid only if signed by the aggrieved party (SB 56).

The agency requests public comment on whether other options should be considered for achieving the rule's substantive goals while reducing the negative economic impact of the rule on business.
