Need for the Rule(s): The new statutory changes of the term "disabled person" to "person with a disability" and other similar changes, necessitate amending rules to be consistent with the changes in terminology.

Fiscal and Economic Impact, including Statement of Cost of Compliance: The proposed rule amendments are required in order to be consistent with newly enacted amendments to statutes. There is no fiscal impact of the rules on the bureau, and no economic impact of the rules on businesses or the public.

How were small businesses involved in the development of this rule?

Small business are not involved because the statutory changes on which the proposed rule amendments are based have already been enacted. There is no substantive impact of the proposed rule amendments on businesses.
