DAS Buildings Savings Update

State agencies are currently required to reduce the amount of use of nonrenewable energy by at least 10 percent from the amount used by the state agency in the 2000 calendar year.

Current usage and cost is reported in a two-month period.

Electricity is reported in kilowatt-hours (kWh) and gas in therms. This data is not adjusted for weather or any other factors.

The % column is combined electric and gas savings in Btu's compared to the year 2000 usage. **The % Change is reported year-to-date for 2006.**
