

Statewide or Multi-Agency Applicability From July 2001 - June 2003

Listed below are ideas identified as having potential statewide or multi-agency impact since July 1997. Take a look and see whether you might be able to put one of these great ideas to work in your agency!

As of January 1998, when the Employee Suggestion Awards Commission determines an adopted suggestion is applicable statewide or to multiple agencies, other than the agenc(ies) listed on the Suggestion Application, a bonus award will be provided to the Suggestor. Suggestors eligible for cash awards will receive 25% of the original award, up to a maximum of \$1,000. Suggestors eligible for non-cash awards will receive a special non-cash award selected specifically to recognize the increased potential for return to the State of Oregon.
