

The Central Evaluation Team (CET)

Nine state management employees, trained in the Hay method, make up the CET. They are from the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) and State agencies. The Team generally meets twice a month, depending on need and other priorities.

From a state-wide perspective, the CET evaluates new or significantly changed class specifications. The CET also evaluates individual Management and Executive Service "benchmark" positions in the Principal Executive/Manager (PE/M) structure. Human Resource Services Division (HRSD) policy 20.000.05 defines classification benchmark position and identifies mandatory benchmarks.
