PTD and survivors' benefits are based on Average Weekly Wage (AWW) of injury year; TTD maximum applies to benefits paid during a fiscal year, thereby providing an escalator factor.

\*For injuries from Jan. 1, 2002 through Dec. 31, 2004, the first 64 unscheduled degrees are paid at \$184.00 per degree; the next 96 degrees are at \$321.00 per degree; above 160 degrees the value is \$748.00 per degree. Scheduled degrees are paid at \$559.00 per degree. Due to law changes, degrees are not used for injuries on or after Jan. 1, 2005.

\*\*Maximum possible benefit for PPD, including both Impairment and Work Disability. Maximum Work Disability rating is 142%.
