^{**}For injuries from Jan. 1, 2010, benefit for child with no surviving parent is increased to 4.35 x 66 2/3% AWW, while child is attending higher education, until age 23 or graduation.

^{***}For injuries from Jan. 1, 2010, through June 30, 2010, burial allowance is increased to 20 x AWW (\$16,012.00).
