PTD and survivors' benefits are based on Average Weekly Wage (AWW) of injury year; TTD maximum applies to benefits paid during a fiscal year, thereby providing an escalator factor. For details, see Bulletin No. 111, Oregon Workers' Compensation Division.

*Maximum possible benefit for PPD, including both Impairment and Work Disability. Maximum Work Disability rating is 142 percent.

**Benefits for surviving children continue until age 18, or 23 if attending higher education. If there is no surviving parent, benefit is 4.35 x 66 2/3% AWW. Effective Jan. 1, 2018, benefits for surviving children continue until age 19. Children between the ages of 19 and 26 attending higher education, will receive monthly benefits for not more than 48 months.

*** HB 2337 and HB 2338, passed during the 2017 legislative session, made changes to minimum and maximum PTD amounts and surviving children benefits effective Jan. 1, 2018.
