^{**}Benefits for surviving children continue until age 18, or 23 if attending higher education. If there is no surviving parent, benefit is 4.35 x 66 2/3 percent AWW. Effective Jan. 1, 2018, benefits continue for surviving children continue until age 19. If children between the ages of 19 and 26 are attending higher education, they will receive monthly benefits for not more than 48 months.

^{***} HB 2337 and HB 2338, passed during the 2017 legislative session, made changes to minimum and maximum PTD amounts and surviving children benefits effective Jan. 1, 2018.
