^{**}Benefits for surviving children continue until age 18, or 23 if attending higher education. If no surviving parent, benefit is 4.35 x 66 2/3% AWW. Effective Jan. 1, 2018, benefits continue for surviving children until age 19. If a child between the ages of 19 and 26 is attending higher education, they will receive monthly benefits for not more than 48 months.

^{***} HB 2337 and HB 2338, passed during the 2017 legislative session, made changes to minimum and maximum PTD amounts and surviving children benefits effective Jan. 1, 2018.
