

Urgent pharmacy billing information Required changes to Point of Sale transactions

Effective with the replacement MMIS, the following changes are mandatory for B1 and B3 Point of Sale (POS) transactions. These changes are listed on page 2 of the Oregon DHS Payer Sheet.

Client's name is now required in the Insurance Segment

In the previous Point of Sale (POS) system, the client name was always in the patient segment of the NCPDP Pharmacy Payer Sheet. Now, the client's first name and last name is mandatory and must be entered in fields 312-CC and 313-CD of the Insurance Segment.

You may have it correct in one of your screens and not be aware that it needs to be either added or corrected in the new area.

Client's date of birth is required in the Patient Segment

DHS requires the client's date of birth (DOB) in field 304-C4 of the Patient Segment.
