Mr. Wenneson is completing pilot implementation of [ARCHHIE](#), a health information exchange for the six consortium clinics incorporating lessons learned and improvements from Mendocino SHARE and the NHIN Prototype efforts.

Mr. Wenneson is currently on the Network Workgroup chartered by the federal [Office of the National Coordinator](#) for Health Information Technology. This workgroup develops definitions of key health information technology terms for Health Information Exchange and Regional Health Information Organization (RHIO). He is a PMI-certified Project Management Professional (PMP) and has a Masters in Business Administration.
