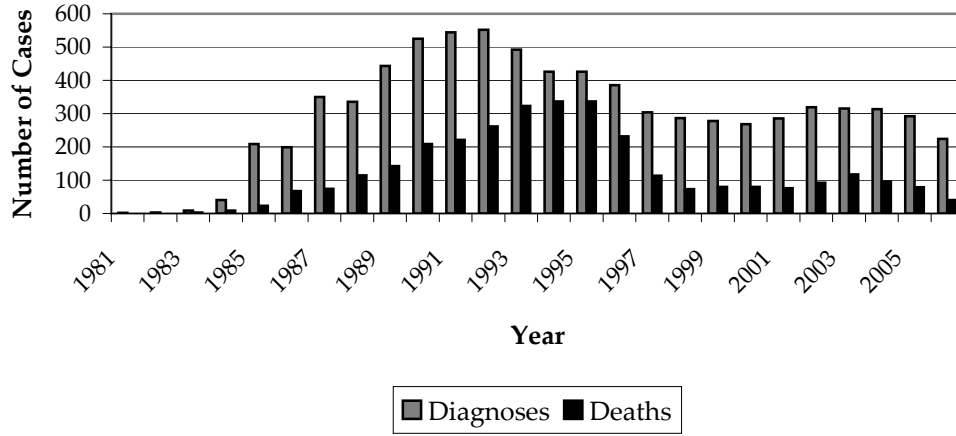

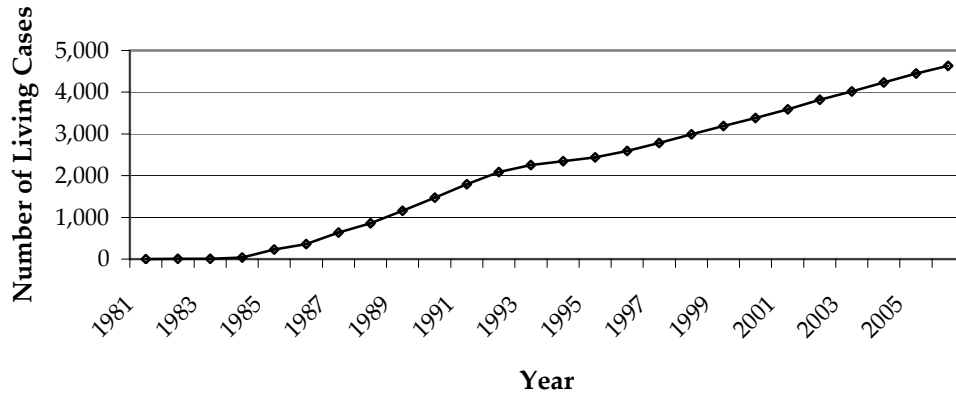

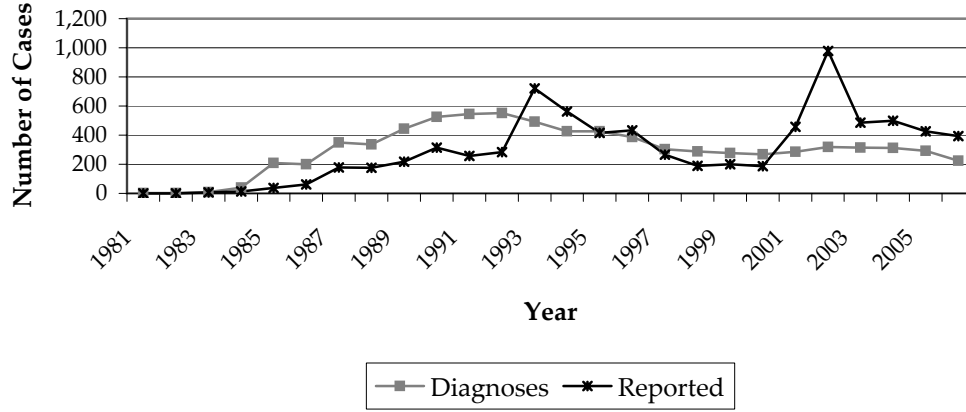
### Oregon HIV/AIDS Diagnoses and Deaths
