Changes to the Inmate Misconduct Rule

A new version of the Oregon Administrative Rule on Prohibited Inmate Conduct (291-105) will go into effect on midnight, July 1, 2009. The main changes you will see in the new rule are:

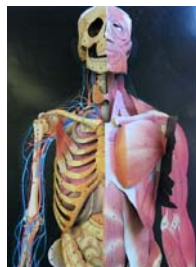
- Changes to the names and definitions of violations
- Changes to the sanctioning grid
- Conduct history will shorten from four years to two

Please note that the effective date of the new rule is midnight, July 1, 2009. This means that any DR's you receive prior to this date and time will be processed using the current rule, even if your hearing is scheduled after this date. Any DR's you receive after midnight July 1st will be processed with the new revised rule.

The new rule on prohibited inmate conduct will be available for review in your institution's Library after July 1, 2009.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Why is mail from my attorney and the courts being opened?

A: The most likely answer is the piece of mail was not properly designated as legal mail.

Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 291-131-0010(14) legal mail is defined as incoming or outgoing mail to or from an attorney, court, or court official which is clearly worded "legal mail" on the addressee side of the envelope. To qualify as legal mail and be afforded special processing, mail which otherwise qualifies as legal mail (from an attorney, court or court official) must have affixed to the address side of the envelope or parcel the words "legal mail".

Occasionally, a piece of mail that is properly designated as legal mail will be accidentally opened. When this happens, a stamp is placed on the envelope indicating the piece of mail was opened, but that the contents were not reviewed.

Q: Why is mail from the Internal Review Service, Veterans Affairs and Department of Education being opened?

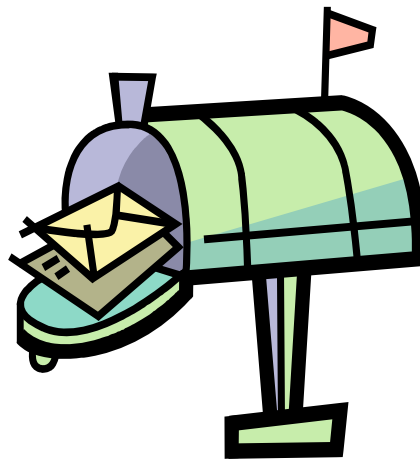
A: It is easy to understand why one may think mail for these entities qualifies as legal mail, but in fact it does not.

Pursuant to OAR 291-131-0010(18) Official Mail is defined as incoming and outgoing mail addressed to or from officials of the confining authority, the Governor, the Secretary of State, Oregon's state legislators, Oregon's United States Congressional delegation, tribal governments, administrators of grievance systems, foreign embassy consulate, and members of the paroling authority, which is clearly worded "official mail" on the addressee side of the envelope.

Q: Why am I not getting the catalogs I requested?

A: The most likely reason is that the mail is not properly addressed, catalogs must contain the inmate's full name and SID number.

Pursuant to OAR 291-131-0025(6) Inmates may receive catalogs, advertisements, brochures, promotional materials, pamphlets, sweepstakes, and contest materials solicited by the inmate provided the materials are properly addressed with the inmate's full name and SID number and are received directly at the correct address of where the inmate is currently housed. These materials must conform to any content restrictions contained within this rule.
