Meeting called to order at 9:05 am.

### **I. Meeting Minutes**

#### **A. Review of January 11, 2007 Minutes**

**MOTION:** Mr. Simmons moved to approve the minutes, Mr. Bryant seconded; motion passed unanimously.

### **II. Old Business**

- A. Intern Critiques** – Ms. Salle informed the committee that new interns are submitting their first sets of critiques and all evaluations appear to contain positive feedback and comments.
- B. Paul Tesi** – Ms. Salle informed the committee that there has been no communication from Mr. Tesi and the first set of critiques has not yet been received for Intern Tesi. Mr. Bryant informed the committee his understanding was that Mr. Tesi was performing agency-specific polygraphs and may have difficulty reaching 200 exams before his two year intern period expires.
- C. SOSN Bill** – Mr. Wygant informed the committee that he had not drafted a letter as discussed at the previous polygraph meeting, but that the language in question relating to PSOT certification had been removed from the bill and the committee does not have any concern with the bill in its current form.
- D. HB 2227** – Mr. Wygant informed the committee that this bill has passed and is in the process of becoming law.
- E. Greg Anderson** – Ms. Leutwyler informed the Committee she had an opportunity to speak to Mr. Anderson but has been unable to contact the complainant. She has received additional contact numbers from the complainant's attorney and will continue trying to make contact. She will update the Committee on her progress at the September meeting.

**MOTION:** Mr. Simmons moved to table this item until the next meeting. Mr. Bryant seconded; motion passed unanimously.

### III. **New Business**

- A. Polygraph Exam – The Committee members reviewed and discussed the revised test questions and answer key for the general license test. The Committee made several additional revisions to Questions #101, #74, #139, #149 and #118. The Committee also recommended revisiting Question #66 if laws change this legislative session. The polygraph examination test questions will be amended by the Curriculum section as discussed.
- B. Michael Crane – The Committee members reviewed Mr. Crane’s request to reinstate his polygraph license. Ms. Salle informed Committee members the last continuing education credits the Department received for Mr. Crane were for the 1999-2001 licensing period. In order to reinstate his license he would need a total of 90 educational credits (to cover the 2001-2003, 2003-2005 and 2005-2007 periods); a completed application and fees; and he would need to successfully complete a general license examination pursuant to OAR 259-020-0025(2).

The Committee concurred that the above listed requirements would need to be met before Mr. Crane could reinstate his license.

- C. Lucinda Gardner – The Committee members reviewed Ms. Gardner’s request for an extension of time. Ms. Gardner submitted a letter from PSU indicating she was on track to complete her Bachelor’s degree in the spring 2007 term.

**MOTION:** Mr. Simmons moved to extend her intern license until the next meeting in September to determine if all educational requirements had been completed. Ms. Leutwyler seconded, the motion passed unanimously.

- D. HB 2521 – This bill expands the definition of “polygraph examiner” to include examiners who perform voice stress analysis. Mr. Wygant informed the committee he believes bill is going to die in committee.
- E. SB 732 – Mr. Wygant informed the committee this bill relates to pre-employment polygraph testing for police officers and the Polygraph Licensing Advisory Committee has no reason to oppose the bill in its current form.
