**ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES**

- Today DOL announced that Oregon was awarded \$57M in UI Modernization incentive funds. Now 28 states have received incentive payments, with 6 states including Oregon having received both the 1/3 payment for implementing Alternate Benefit Year, and 2/3 for other updates to their UI programs to better meet the needs of the 21<sup>st</sup> century workforce.

- Region 2 (Multnomah, Clackamas, and Washington counties) is working to implement a First Source Hiring Agreement with the City of Portland for ARRA jobs.
- Region 10 (Deschutes, Jefferson, and Crook counties) is following up with ODOT contractors who have been approved for ARRA projects. They are collaborating with Central Oregon Community College to enable claimants and other job seekers to be aware of weatherization training and certification programs. The 1:1 skill review is an ideal time to refer candidates who have a similar skills background or have expressed this career interest.

- Competitive federal grant through ARRA to obtain funding to upgrade Business & Employment Services field office broadband capabilities. The notice of funds availability was just announced on July 1, with grant application due August 14.
- Region 10 and their Local Workforce Investment Board will be working with our Research section to apply for a green jobs grant specific to labor market information. The program would collect additional skills data through the Career Readiness Certification program which will enhance our understanding of the foundational skills and tasks required for green jobs.
