## ACTIONS TAKEN, MAJOR PROJECT UPDATES, AND OTHER MILESTONES

- Several DHS ARRA-funded positions will soon be listed for positions in the Albany area (Human Service Specialist 1 and 3, Social Service Assistants, and Social Service Specialists).
- Additional DHS ARRA-funded positions will be listed for positions in the Roseburg area.
- Staff in the South Coast area are following up on two new Stimulus-funded projects managed by the Army Corps (dredging work) and one road construction project.
- The Klamath Falls office is listing positions for LKE, for work in the National Wildlife Refuge. The project is to build a floating island in Sheepy Lake (water fowl nesting habitat). A description:
 

*“The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Portland District (NWP) has awarded a contract for the installation of a floating island water fowl nesting habitat. The project entails construction of one 3/4 acre floating island in Sheepy Lake, a permanent body of water located within Lower Klamath National Wildlife Refuge (NWR). The island shall be anchored near the center of the southern lobe of Sheepy Lake. Sheepy Lake has an average surface elevation of approximately 4079 feet and is approximately 430 acres in size. The proposed island shall float on the lake's surface and be made of recycled material consisting of polypropylene (from recycled carpet) and polyester (from recycled drinking bottles). Layers of the matrix shall be bonded together with foam. The plastic material shall be stabilized with latex for enhanced UV protection. The island shall be covered by a mixture of small gravel/coarse sand and pumice in order to provide suitable nesting habitat for Caspian terns. “*
- The Ontario one stop office is helping conduct interviews for weatherization positions with a local Community In Action non-profit.

### UPCOMING PLANNED ACTIONS, MAJOR PROJECTS, DEADLINES, AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES

- The Oregon Workforce Investment Board (OWIB) is planning to pursue a State Energy Sector Partnership grant (one of the green jobs grants from DOL). Discussions are underway to integrate current activities into the proposal, and to make the grant seamless with the Green Jobs Strategy the Legislature recently required from OWIB. The grant application is due October 20.
- The Workforce Investment Council of Clackamas County is looking at several grant opportunities funded under the Health Care and Emerging Industries grant opportunity. OED will be a partner on the Energy Training Partnership proposal, which would grant \$5 Million over a 3-year period to create certification and career pathways for new and incumbent workers in the renewable electric industry. The emphasis is on wind and solar. In addition to training, a strong on-the-job component is present. Region 15 would receive \$500,000 in this grant award.
- The Workforce Investment Council of Clackamas County (WICCO) is partnering with OHSU and OIT to work on a Health Care and Emerging Industries Sector grant. The range of the grant will be between \$2M and \$5M; the focus is on Health Informatics. The money will be used to expand opportunities for job seekers for educational opportunities at community colleges in this field, which is seen as an emerging career in the health care arena.
