**Minutes:**

**Old Business:**

Joncile Martin reviewed three issues from discussions at a recent Board meeting. The Board has indicated they would like for CIAC to review these issues and provide suggestions to the Board. Issues are:

- the certified educational programs for apprentices,
- 'breaking' rigor by non-licensed personnel prior to embalming, and

- the definition of a 'public passageway'.

**New Business:**

We continued to review proposed changes to the Oregon Administrative Rules. Some suggested changes were accepted while others will be discussed at the next meeting. These are:

- We will check with Wall re changes on sanitizing the prep room
- Section 830-030-0030, 0040, and 0050 - review to determine if changes need to be made
- On 830-030-0090 (2)(b)(B),(C), (D), hold for discussion to clarify intent of deletion
- 803-030-0100 – Defer for further discussion at next meeting
