

**Oregon Board of Naturopathic Examiners - Formulary Council Meeting Minutes  
September 27, 2006**

**EXCUSED:** Kevin Wilson, ND (Chair); Kathy Raker, RPh

Dr. Marinelli was asked to take over in Dr. Wilson's absence. The meeting opened at 9:07am.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Minutes were approved from the September 28, 2005 meeting. All substances approved and submitted to the Board were adopted in rule.

**Drug Review** (the following substances were submitted, discussed and reviewed by the FC):

**HOUSEKEEPING:** After discussion the FC voted unanimously to include Pseudoephedrine and Naltrexone with Poly L-lactic Acid for consideration by the OBNE for adoption into 850-060-0225 and 850-060-0226. A spelling error in 850-060-0226(110) will be made at the time of adoption.

**BIOLOGICALS:** Dr. Wilson, Chair of the FC, asked to have "biologicals" put on the agenda for discussion. In his absence, this discussion will be held over until the spring 2007 meeting. At the suggestion of Dr. Block, Dr. Marinelli will work with Dr. Wilson to define biological and determine if it should be listed in -0225. A review of -0225 will be done to determine if there are other classifications listed under substances that should not be.

**DIURETICS:** Discussion was held on diuretics not being on the formulary, therefore, not available for NDs. The statute really must be revised to allow ND's access to primary care drugs. Discussion was held on the possibility of the OBNOE working with other health professionals to assure patients get appropriate care by all practitioners and not be limited to allopathic physicians for primary care.

**NEXT MEETING DATE:** The next Formulary Council meeting was tentatively set for March 21, 2007, 9:00am. (NOTE: Ms. Walsh confirmed this with council members after the meeting)
