

Proposed Board of Forestry Strategic Planning, Implementation, and Monitoring Work Plan Goals and Objectives

GOAL: To lead Oregon in implementing policies and programs that promote environmentally, economically, and socially sustainable management of Oregon's public and private forests. (from the Board of Forestry's current mission statement)

OBJECTIVE 1: Build Oregonians' understanding, acceptance, and support for sustainable forest management and increase recognition of the Board of Forestry's role in leading Oregon in forest policy forums using the *Forestry Program for Oregon* vision, values, goals and objectives as the basis for discussion.

OBJECTIVE 2: Measure progress towards achieving the *Forestry Program for Oregon* goals and objectives through the use of relevant indicators of sustainable forest management and evaluations of Board performance.

OBJECTIVE 3: Solicit unfiltered, high quality public input and use this input, along with indicators, other assessment and accomplishment information, and other stakeholder involvement as adaptive management tools for *Forestry Program for Oregon* implementation, updating *Forestry Program for Oregon* objectives, and Board Work planning.

OBJECTIVE 4: Develop and implement Board Work Plans to achieve the goals and objectives of the *Forestry Program for Oregon* and the statutory responsibilities of the Board in an efficient, effective, and transparent manner.

OBJECTIVE 5: Oversee outcomes of Department of Forestry work that is directly linked to Board strategic planning.
