**RULE SUMMARY**

These rules describe the procedures and requirements for the application and issuance of custom registration plates—sometimes referred to as personalized license plates. Chapter 311, OL 2007, directs DMV to issue custom registration plates that contain the words “Medal of Honor” to qualified Congressional Medal of Honor recipients. The temporary amendments add new provisions to DMV’s custom plate rules to comply with the new statutory requirements.

**Need for the Temporary Rule(s):**

This temporary rulemaking is needed to implement legislation enacted by the 2007 Legislative Assembly:

OAR 735-046-0010 and 735-046-0050, are the DMV rules that describe the procedures and requirements for the application and issuance of custom registration plates—sometimes referred to as personalized license plates. Chapter 311, Oregon Laws 2007, directs DMV to issue custom registration plates that contain the words “Medal of Honor” to qualified Congressional Medal of Honor recipients. The temporary amendment of OAR 735-046-0010 and 735-046-0050 adds new provisions to DMV’s custom plate rules to comply with the requirements of Chapter 311, Oregon Laws 2007. Additional changes to language within the amended text are made for purposes of clarity.

**Justification of Temporary Rules(s):** The temporary amendment of these rules is necessitated by the enactment of Chapter 311, Oregon Laws 2007, which becomes effective on January 1, 2008. DMV intends to permanently amend these rules, however, there is not sufficient time to complete the permanent rulemaking process to coincide with the effective date of the Act.

DMV finds that its failure to act promptly will result in the untimely amendment of OAR 735-046-0010 and 735-046-0050, respectively, which is required to implement Chapter 311, Oregon Laws 2007. Failure to act immediately will result in the untimely and possibly confusing implementation of these legislative initiatives.
