RULE SUMMARY

Chapter 588, Oregon Laws 2007 made changes to the program that allows limited driving privileges to a person with a low vision condition who uses a bioptic telescopic lens while driving. These amended rules remove the restriction of only driving on roads with a speed limit of 45 mph or less, allow nighttime driving under certain circumstances, require a nighttime driving training program, establish procedures for issuing driving privileges without a daylight only restriction, and clarify that a person may be granted driving privileges without meeting vision standards if they qualify under the limited vision condition program.
