

Geo-Hydro-Environmental Drawing Order and Sheet Numbering

Drawings produced for the variety of technical disciplines represented in the Geo-Hydro-Environmental Group will be displayed in a manner consistent with the *Contract Plans Development Guide, Volume 1, Technical Information*. The Geo-Hydro-Environmental sheets will be located between Roadway Engineering and Bridge Engineering sheets in the contract plans.

The following letters are reserved for the Geo-Hydro-Environmental technical disciplines:

GA: Erosion Control
GB: Geotechnical Data
GC: Retaining Walls
GE: Culverts
GF: Fish Passage
GG: Temporary Water Management
GH: Bank Protection
GJ: Stormwater
GK: Landslide Correction
GL: HazMat
GM: Material Source/Disposal Sites
GN: Roadside Development
GP: Waterway Enhancement
GQ: *Rockfall Mitigation* (new)

Sheets can be stacked numerically in each of the above disciplines; however, do not use the letters "I" and "O", to avoid confusion with numerals. Sheet numbering within a series shall be accomplished using number extensions beginning with number 2 (i.e., GA, GA-2, GA-3, GA-4...), and so forth.
