**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairperson, Dave Sherden called the meeting of the Board of Athletic Trainers to order at 9:21 a.m. on Monday, February 24, 2005, at the Health Licensing Office (HLO), 700 Summer St NE, Salem, Oregon. Board members were connected via telephone conference call at which time a roll call was performed.

Administrative Rules

Ms. Allbritton stated the purpose of the meeting is to review the administrative rulemaking testimony, recommendations from the hearings officer, and advice from the agency's legal counsel. She stated the proposed rules were filed to provide notice of rulemaking and opportunity for public comment from stakeholders and interested parties. Ms. Allbritton stated that HLO had received considerable written and oral testimony. She gave an overview of the hearing's officer report, which stated that the proposed rule exceeded statutory authority, and recommended that the agency not adopt these rules.

Ms. Allbritton reported that the agency had received conflicting advice regarding statutory authority. She recommended that based on the hearing's officer report and legal advice, the rules not be adopted.

Chairperson Dave Sheridan called for discussion. He stated he read the report and said that the case against permanent rule adoption was stronger than the case for adopting.

Board members stated that the language wasn't exactly what they had intended.

Ms Stotts made a motion, and Ms. Wolcott seconded to table the rule adoption. The motion passed unanimously with Mr. Sherden, Ms. Stotts, Mr. Iverson, Mr. Rask, Ms. Wolcott voting aye under a roll call vote.

Ms. Allbritton stated that interested parties would be notified of the decision.

The meeting adjourned at 9:35 a.m.
