What is the purpose of the Meeting?

To discuss and review examination questions. The meeting will be held in Executive Session under:

- ORS 192.660(2)(f) to consider information or records exempt from public inspection for example, examination questions;
- ORS 192.660 (2)(h) consultation with legal counsel concerning legal rights and duties regarding current litigation or litigation likely to be filed and;

No final actions or final decisions will be made in executive session. The board/council will return to open session before taking any final action or making any final decisions.

What is the Executive Session Process?

Prior to entering into executive session the board/council chairperson will announce the nature of and the authority for holding executive session, at which time all audience members are asked to leave the room with the exception of news media and designated staff.

Board meetings called for the sole purpose of Executive Session are considered public meetings and adhere to the public meetings law under ORS 192.620.
