Revision of the Steelhead Supplement

A complete draft of the Steelhead Supplement was distributed in mid-December 1997. Some changes were made to this draft based in part on comments received from the National Marine Fisheries Service staff and from individuals and organizations that reviewed the draft. In an effort to conserve limited natural resources and funds, *only the revised portions* of the Steelhead Supplement will be distributed to those who received the December 17, 1997, draft. This material, added to or replacing sections of the December 17 draft, now constitutes the Steelhead Supplement to the Oregon Plan.

Consequently, material that has been added to or which replaces sections of the December 17 draft will contain a date of February 6, 1998, in the footer. Material that has not been revised will still carry the December 17, 1997, date in the footer. The Oregon Plan web page will also be revised to display the new material.

Finalizing the December 1997 draft of the Steelhead Supplement:

To finalize the December 1997 draft, look to the Revised Table of Contents following this page. Shaded sections indicate that new information is provided in addition to or replacing the draft information. Follow this table as you add or replace pages in the draft.

Look to the page numbers of the revised material. If the revised page has a lower case letter after the page number, *this page is in addition to* the pages of the draft and should be added *after* the draft page number. For example, you'll see that the first revised page is numbered *3-4a*. This page should be added after the draft page numbered 3-4. If the revised page does not have a lower case letter after the page number, *this page replaces* pages in the draft. For example, you'll find revised pages numbered *4-1* through *4-32*. These pages replace the entire first section of Chapter 4, or draft pages numbered 4-1 through 4-31.

Follow these rules for addition and replacement throughout the draft Steelhead Supplement to create the final Steelhead Supplement to the Oregon Plan for Salmon and Watersheds.
