2) Random Spot Compliance Checks; a stratified random spot check at certain intervals to assess compliance with prohibited conditions identified in agricultural water quality management area plans. Since it would be impractical to monitor the entire agricultural landscape, a +/-5% annual spot check of agricultural operations will be conducted to assess compliance with the plans. The spot checks will also enable ODA to establish baseline monitoring conditions for agricultural lands where they presently do not exist. [NOTE: This is similar to the approach taken by the Natural Resources Conservation Service in assessing compliance with the Farm Service Agency's Highly Erodible Lands Program].
