TODAY'S GUEST SPEAKER - Eric Corliss

He joined the Oregon Trail Chapter of the American Red Cross as the Director of Emergency Services in May of 2008. In this role, he works with a team of six employees and 400+ volunteers to prepare for and respond to disasters, conduct emergency communication between members of the Armed Forces and their families, deliver International Services and provide Community Disaster Education for sixteen counties across the top of Oregon.

Prior to returning home to Oregon and to join the Oregon Trail Chapter, Eric had served as the Director of Response for the Mile High Chapter in Denver, CO, Readiness Program Manager for Red Cross National Headquarters in Washington DC and as a Disaster Specialist for Red Cross National Headquarters assigned to FEMA Regional X. Eric has directed and been on the Red Cross incident management team for more than 20 significant disasters around the county to include Egypt Air Crash in Rhode Island, the September 11th, 2001 response to the Pentagon in Washington DC and the World Trade Center in New York City, NY and Hurricane Katrina in Baton Rouge, LA.

Our next meeting is Tuesday, November 3, at 10 a.m. at the 911 Center. Guest speaker will be Senator Betsy Johnson who will give us a legislative update. Rep. Brad Witt may be joining us by telephone. Treats and door prizes are being provided by Georgia-Pacific, Wauna.
