- SONL/R&R: The Board started taking applications for relief and reclass
- Seven hearings have been held / 40-50 petitions received and reviewed so far
- Expect an increase in volume of hearings / so far everything has been smooth
- Introduced Greta Lowry, newest Board Member – comes from Lincoln county, she started May 14th
- John Bailey will be arriving July 1st – comes from Multnomah County Probation and Parole
- Move – because of continuous expansion, we will be moving to a new location
- Building construction seems to be ahead of schedule - target move in date of August 5th
- HB 2045 – passed both chambers; waiting for governor's signature

- Patty – board has conducted regional Probation & Parole officer training – positive feedback from counties on training
- Patty – as has been discussed – recommendation has come up to eliminate SC10 for convicted domestic violence female offenders – starting July 1st this will no longer be automatically assigned
