

Facilities Operations Checklist



Each building may have a few specific needs based on its unique location and architecture.

Below is a list of baseline considerations you may want to reassess regularly.

EXTERIOR AND PERIMETER SECURITY			
	EXTERIOR LIGHTING Automatically controlled. A well-lit exterior is a proven deterrent for unwanted activity.		WINDOWS If windows can be opened, ensure they are locked. Possibly install open/closed sensors on ground level. Use tempered glass on ground level
	EXTERIOR ACCESS CONTROLS Secured exterior locksets controlled with card reader Badges for access.		DOORS Hardened wherever feasible. Hinge pins should be internal, welded, or otherwise treated to prevent removal.
	CAMERAS Exterior cameras to cover entry and exit points of the building. Clear lines of sight are crucial.		EMERGENCY POWER If applicable, ensure access controls are connected to Emergency power. Ensure generator is securely enclosed.
	LANDSCAPING Keep hedges and bushes trimmed to prevent hiding spots. Be mindful of items in the landscaping that can be used as weapons or tools.		UTILIY ACCESS POINTS Ensure utility access points are secured by a controlled means when not in use.
INTERIOR SECURITY			
	LOBBIES Interior/exterior cameras if necessary.		ELEVATORS Card access on all elevators to require badging before operation. Floor tracking is also recommended.
	STAIRWELLS Card access controls on all stairwell entries to deter unwanted entry.		INTERIOR LIGHTING Automatically controlled. Provide adequate lighting to assist with interior cameras.
	PUBLIC SPACES Are waiting areas routinely searched? Are public bathrooms routinely searched? Do public trash receptacles easily conceal hazards?		FIRE EXITS Ensure the fire exits and egress paths are clearly marked and posted.
