Catlin Gabel has an employee commute options program that offers something for everyone. As part of the school's plan for achieving environmental sustainability, they offer the following incentives:

- One dollar cafeteria credit for every day employee uses a commute option other than driving alone
- Bike facilities including covered bicycle parking and showers
- Carpool parking spaces for staff and students
- Telecommuting and compressed work weeks for certain jobs and times of year
