Plan approval does not negate the responsibility of the owner to provide additional facilities should the completed work fail to achieve design effluent parameters, unforeseen water quality violations occur, other operational problems develop, or treatment standards or requirements change. Review of non-process related aspects of the plans will be cursory, if reviewed at all, and not meant to assure adequacy of nonprocess related aspects of the design.
