Addendum Number 1

In accordance with OAR 340-216-0084, condition 6.3 now reads as follows:

6.3 Ambient Monitoring

The permittee must conduct ambient monitoring during a period when odor events are most likely to occur, but not later than December 31, 2012. A sampling protocol must be developed and approved by the Department prior to the monitoring. The sampling protocol must include the following provisions:

- i. Two separate sampling periods when odor events are expected to occur;
- ii. At least three sampling locations (background upwind of plant, downwind near the plant, and downwind up on the bluff) during each sampling period; and
- iii. The samples analyzed primarily for naphthalene.

Addendum 1 Review Report

Standard Air Contaminant Discharge Permit (ACDP) 33-0003-ST-01 was issued to Amerities West, LLC on May 19, 2009. Permit condition 6.3 required the permittee to conduct ambient monitoring in coordination with the DEQ by March 31, 2009. The intent was that DEQ would participate in the monitoring project by assisting with the collection of samples and/or conducting the laboratory analysis of the samples. However, due to budget cuts, DEQ was unable to participate in the ambient monitoring project as intended. Therefore, the permit condition is being revised to require Amerities West to conduct the monitoring based on a sampling protocol approved by the DEQ. In addition, the due date for completing the monitoring project is adjusted to allow time to complete the monitoring and obtain results before the next permit renewal (4/1/13). It is anticipated that the samples will be collected in the late spring or early fall of 2011 and in January or February of 2012. These periods of the year correspond to when DEQ has received the most complaints regarding odors from the facility.
