 - Written documentation of approved component swapping and/or re-designation practices on how the applicant intends to satisfy warranty and in-use compliance requirements.
 - Written instructions for assessing if the system still meets the verified emissions reductions (for PM and/or NOx) instructions for device movement to prevent installation on an inappropriate vehicle.
- 2) To provide a written statement confirming installer agrees to honor original installation warranty and warranty period
 - If the installer of either a swapped or re-designated diesel emission control strategy is not the original installer of the original installation, the new installer must assume the installation warranty responsibilities defined in section [2702 of the CCR Title 13 \(2020\)](#).
- 3) To follow all manufacturers' instructions. Swapping or Re-Designation of components is only allowable per manufacturers' standards and warranty information. Not all manufacturers allow swapping of components or re-designation.
 - Oregon DEQ must receive a copy of written permission from manufacturer if manufacturer requires written approval prior to Swap or Re-Designation.

NO component Swap or Re-Designation of is allowed until Review and Approval of this application from Oregon DEQ.
