Medium- and Heavy-Duty One-Time Fleet Reporting

What is the One-Time Medium- and Heavy-**Duty Fleet Reporting Requirement?**

It is a one-time reporting requirement for large entities and government fleets that own, operate or direct the movement of on-road vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) greater than 8,500 lbs. This applies to vehicles such as trucks, buses or delivery vans.

When is the reporting deadline?

You must fill out and submit the reporting form spreadsheet by June 30, 2022.

Who must report?

You must report if you are a fleet owner, business, government agency, municipality or broker with onroad vehicles over 8,500 lbs. GVWR, if in 2021 your entity operated a facility in Oregon and meets any of the following criteria:

- Had gross annual revenues greater than \$50 million in the U.S. for the 2021 tax year, including revenues from all subsidiaries, subdivisions or branches, and had one or more vehicles under common ownership or control that were operated in Oregon in 2021;
- Any fleet owner in the 2021 calendar year that had five or more vehicles under common ownership or control;
- Any broker or entity that dispatched five or more vehicles into or throughout Oregon in the 2021 calendar year;
- Any Oregon government agency, including all state and local municipalities, that had five or more vehicles that were operated in Oregon in
- Any federal government agency that had five or more vehicles that were operated in Oregon in 2021.

Reporting is not required for military or emergency vehicles or vehicles awaiting sale.

Which information must I report?

Affected entities need to report information, such as vehicle type, miles traveled, weight class and homebase location. A guidance document with instructions on how to report is available.

How do I report?

On the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality website, download the fleet reporting spreadsheet and complete the reporting form Excel spreadsheet on your own computer. Then, email the form to

What types of vehicles must be reported?

You must report on-road vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating GVWR greater than 8,500 lbs.



Background

In November 2021, DEO adopted the Clean Trucks Rule. It has a one-time reporting requirement for large businesses, government agencies or contractors that operate or dispatch vehicles with a manufacturer's GVWR greater than 8,500 lbs. in Oregon. The information collected through this process will help inform DEQ when developing policies and recommendations to accelerate a large-scale transition to zeroemission medium- and heavy-duty vehicle fleets.
