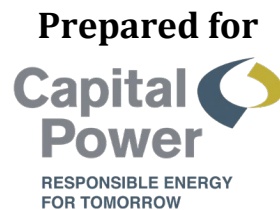

### OAR 345-021-0010(1)(cc)

*(cc) Exhibit CC. Identification, by legal citation, of all state statutes and administrative rules and local government ordinances containing standards or criteria that the proposed facility must meet for the Council to issue a site certificate, other than statutes, rules and ordinances identified in Exhibit E, and identification of the agencies administering those statutes, administrative rules and ordinances. The applicant must identify all statutes, administrative rules and ordinances that the applicant knows to be applicable to the proposed facility, whether or not identified in the project order. To the extent not addressed by other materials in the application, the applicant must include a discussion of how the proposed facility meets the requirements of the applicable statutes, administrative rules and ordinances.*

This section describes state statutes and administrative rules not discussed in Exhibit E. These statutes and rules are discussed in other sections of the Application for Site Certificate; the applicable section is indicated below.

## **2.0 Spill Response Statutes**

In regard to reporting and responding to spills or the release of hazardous materials, the following rules and statutes contain state and federal spill reporting requirements:

- Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 466.635;
- OAR Chapter 340, Divisions 45, 47, 108, 122, 150, 160;
- 33 Code of Federal Regulations part 153; and
- 40 Code of Federal Regulations parts 110, 122, 262, 265, 280, 302, 355, 761.

Oregon agencies that may be required to be notified in the event of spill or the release of hazardous materials of reportable quantities include:

- Oregon Emergency Management Division;
- Oregon Department of Environmental Quality; and
- Oregon Department of State Police.

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
