


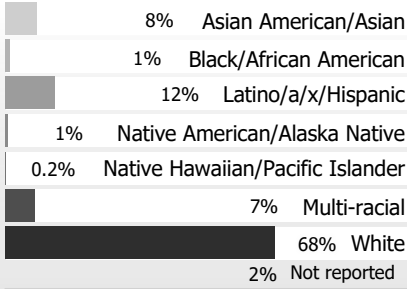

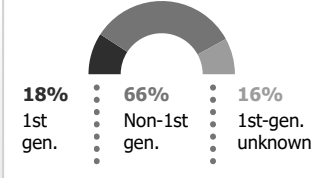
### Race/Ethnicity



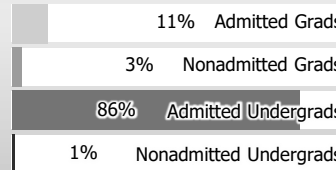
Students of color are increasingly represented on campuses. Currently, nearly **30%** of students identify as students of color.

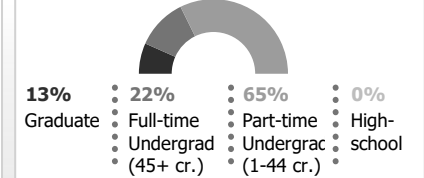
### 1st-Generation Status



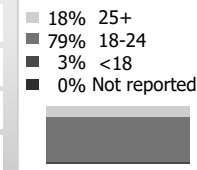
### Primary Area of Instruction (most credits)



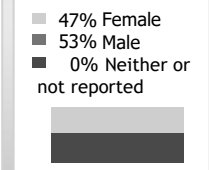

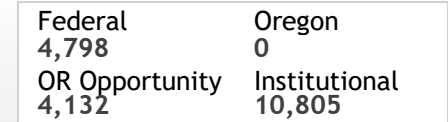

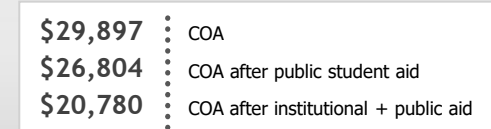
### Unable to Meet College Expenses with Expected Resources



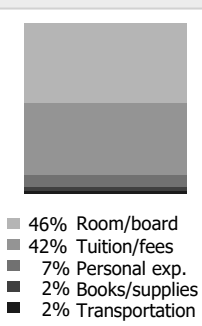
### Students Receiving Financial Aid



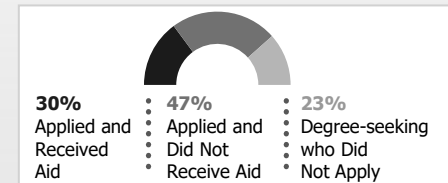
### Average Cost of Attendance (COA)



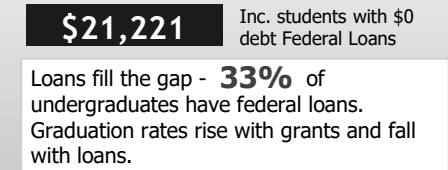

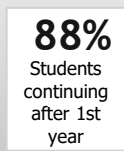

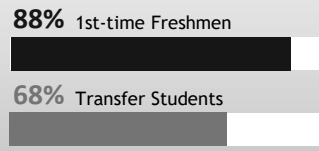
### Completion Rates



### Retention Rate

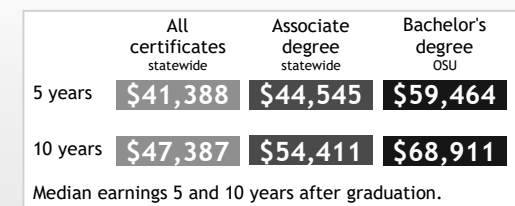


### Bachelor's Completion Rate if continued to junior year
