Oregon approved bovine HPAI samplers are dairy owners or employees that have been approved by the Oregon Department of Agriculture to collect samples for Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) testing at a National Animal Health Laboratory Network (NAHLN) laboratory.
