



## Reciprocal Licensing Agreement

As a reciprocal licensing applicant, I understand that by becoming licensed in the State of Oregon as a Commercial Pesticide Applicator, a Public Pesticide Applicator, or a Pesticide Consultant, I agree to comply with all laws and regulations.

I have read Oregon's Pesticide Control Law (ORS 634), Oregon's Pesticide Control Administrative Rules (OAR 603-057), Oregon's Department of Environmental Quality Administrative Rules (OAR 603-109), the Oregon Pesticide Licensing Guide, and the Oregon Forest Practices Act (if applicable), available through the Oregon Department of Agriculture's website at:
