








Mass Shootings Since 2019



2022-2023 Grant Applications Report

2022-23 Grant Applications Report (Pre-deadline)

- RFA Open from April 29 to June 3
- Application Webinars held on May 10 (English) and May 12 (Spanish)
- Both sessions were recorded and posted on ODE website
- All materials provided in English and Spanish

2022-23 Grant Applications Report (Post-deadline)

28 applications submitted

Approx \$6.5 million in requests (\$6,086,000 available to award)

All five regions represented (Metro and Northwest regions highest number of applications submitted)

Applicant types:

- CBO: 11
- Early Learning Providers: 1
- School Districts: 9
- ESD: 4
- Post-secondary: 4

2022-23 Grant Applications Next Steps

- Applications currently being reviewed
- After applications are scored, grantees will be notified
- Grant agreements & project descriptions drafted & reviewed by DOJ for approval
- Funds expected to go out by September
- ODE staff will develop renewal application process for next biennium (2023-2025)
