



Presentation Guidelines

Directions: Your task is to create a presentation to give to the class surrounding your article. You can choose one of the articles provided or you can do a little research among the Smoke Signals website and choose your own:

Offer the different perspectives around the topic, present your own perspectives, and include how you came to that conclusion. ***What are your thoughts and what are they based on?*** Do research beyond your article. Other research can include other articles, interviews, or videos. You choose the format of your presentation, but some suggestions or formats may be a speech, slideshow, poster, video, or pamphlet.

Your Presentation Should Include:

- A summary of the topic. Give the background so your classmates understand the topic enough to understand the different perspectives you will present. Include information from your article and additional research you did about your topic.
- Diverse perspectives. Offer the different viewpoints of the stakeholders that are surrounding your article or hot topic. These can include Tribal council, tribal membership, the state of Oregon, the Federal Government, the local school district, surrounding community, and/or more.
- Be organized and clear in your thoughts. Make sure your audience can follow your presentation and they have a clear understanding of what you are trying to convey.
- You have 7 to 10 minutes for your presentation so be precise and include what you need. Have a good plan and practice.
