1. The family in the story catch eels for three days. On Day One they catch 50 eel. On Day Two they catch 75 eel, and on Day Three they catch 100 eel. If they go eeling for one more day and catch 125 eels on Day Four, how many eels would they catch all together?



2. After the family catches the eel, they put them in a basket to carry them home. If 25 eels can fit into one basket, how many baskets will the family need to bring with them to carry the eel they catch on Day Three?

3. On Day One, the little boy and his Papa catch 15 of the 50 eel. If the little boy catches 5 eels, how many does his Papa catch?

4. When the family returns home with their eel, they smoke the eel to save it for wintertime. If they have 80 eels to smoke and only ten eels fit on a smoking stick, how many sticks will they need to smoke all of the eel?
