Subject: Clarification from FHWA concerning the Buy America Act and MAP 21 exempted item list.

The main change allows some items to be "exempted" from the Buy America Foreign Steel Summary.

<u>Note</u>: The Contractor will still need to submit all of the quality compliance documents outlined in the Non-Field Tested Materials Acceptance Guide (NFTMAG) and Plans and Specifications along with a CMO Certification of Materials Origin (form 734-2126) showing the Foreign Source and a value for these items that are on the "Exempted List".

The Project Manager will need to add the information from the CMO to the Foreign Steel Summary (form 734-1968). By checking the Exempted item box and Category A on the form, the material value will be excluded from the total Foreign Steel Allowance.

ODOT determines whether or not the steel is part of the items exempted. **<u>NOT THE</u> <u>CONTRACTOR</u>**

The implementation date of the Buy America amendment of MAP-21 section 1518 was October 1, 2012. The lag time of this notification is due to ongoing conversation with FHWA and further clarification of the "Exempted Items List".
