



Request to Cancel Driving Privileges by Parent or Legal Guardian

DMV will verify that the parent or legal guardian who signs this request is the same one who signed the original application when the driving privileges were issued.

- If it is the same, DMV will mail the driver under 18 years of age a cancellation letter with instructions to surrender their license or permit and stop driving once the cancellation is in effect.
- If it is not the same, the driving privileges will not be canceled. DMV will send the requester a letter explaining why the driving privileges cannot be canceled.

INFORMATION:

The cancellation notice will be mailed to the driver. Mailing this request and/or turning in a license or permit does not affect the driving privileges. The driver's privileges are valid until the effective date of the cancellation.

The canceled driving privileges may be reinstated when: the driver turns 18 years of age; becomes emancipated; or submits a new driver license application signed by their parent or legal guardian. No tests are required unless the permit has been expired for more than one year. No tests are required unless the driver license has been expired for more than two years.
