

## Guide to Obtaining Quotes for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations

Under the Oregon Department of Transportation’s Community Charging Rebates (CCR) program, applicants are required to obtain two (2) quotes for electric vehicle (EV) charging station equipment and installation or a detailed engineering estimate.<sup>1</sup> An applicant can obtain a quote for their EV charging project from their electric utility, local electricians, charging equipment manufacturers or network providers as detailed below.

### Electric Utilities

Applicants should contact their electric utility early in project planning. Many electric utilities in Oregon have existing programs to provide technical assistance or connect customers with an installer.

## Online Quotes

If an applicant is having difficulties obtaining a quote because they are located in a rural or remote location, they may opt for an online quote.

- [Qmerit](#) can provide a Digital Commercial Assessment. Applicants can complete the brief online form, providing information about the property, the charging project and a few photos.

*Note: To be accepted under CCR, quotes must contain the following information: the project site address, the quantity of chargers, the number of ports, and itemized costs. Each quote should reflect the same site design (i.e., number of ports and charger type), which must match the information provided in the CCR application.*
