

Summary of the Changes to the 2021 Oregon Practitioner Credentialing and Recredentialing Applications Reflected in the 2023 Applications

This document summarizes the changes to the 2021 Oregon Practitioner Credentialing and Recredentialing Applications as recommended by the Advisory Committee on Physician Credentialing Information and approved by the Oregon Health Authority Director on 1/20/23.

Oregon Practitioner Credentialing Application (OPCA):

Section XVIII Peer References Section:

- Add a box for the credentials of applicant's peer references.

Section XVII Professional Work History:

- Remove "current" and "previous" from work history to eliminate unnecessary confusion by interested parties

Section III Specialty Information:

- Change the link for the most current specialties list to URL <https://x12.org/codes/provider-taxonomy-codes> to maintain continuity with federal specialties list

Oregon Practitioner Recredentialing Application (OPRA):

Section XVIII Peer References Section:

- Add a box for the credentials of applicant's peer references.

Section XII Hospital and Other Health Care Facility Affiliations:

- To maintain consistency between the OPCA and OPRA, add one section to XII-A (to make room for four affiliations) and remove one from XII-B (to reduce applications in process to two)

Section III Specialty Information:

- Change the link for the most current specialties list to URL <https://x12.org/codes/provider-taxonomy-codes> to maintain continuity with federal specialties list

Section III Specialty Information:

- Add a space between "Clinical Practice" and checkboxes below for aesthetic purposes
