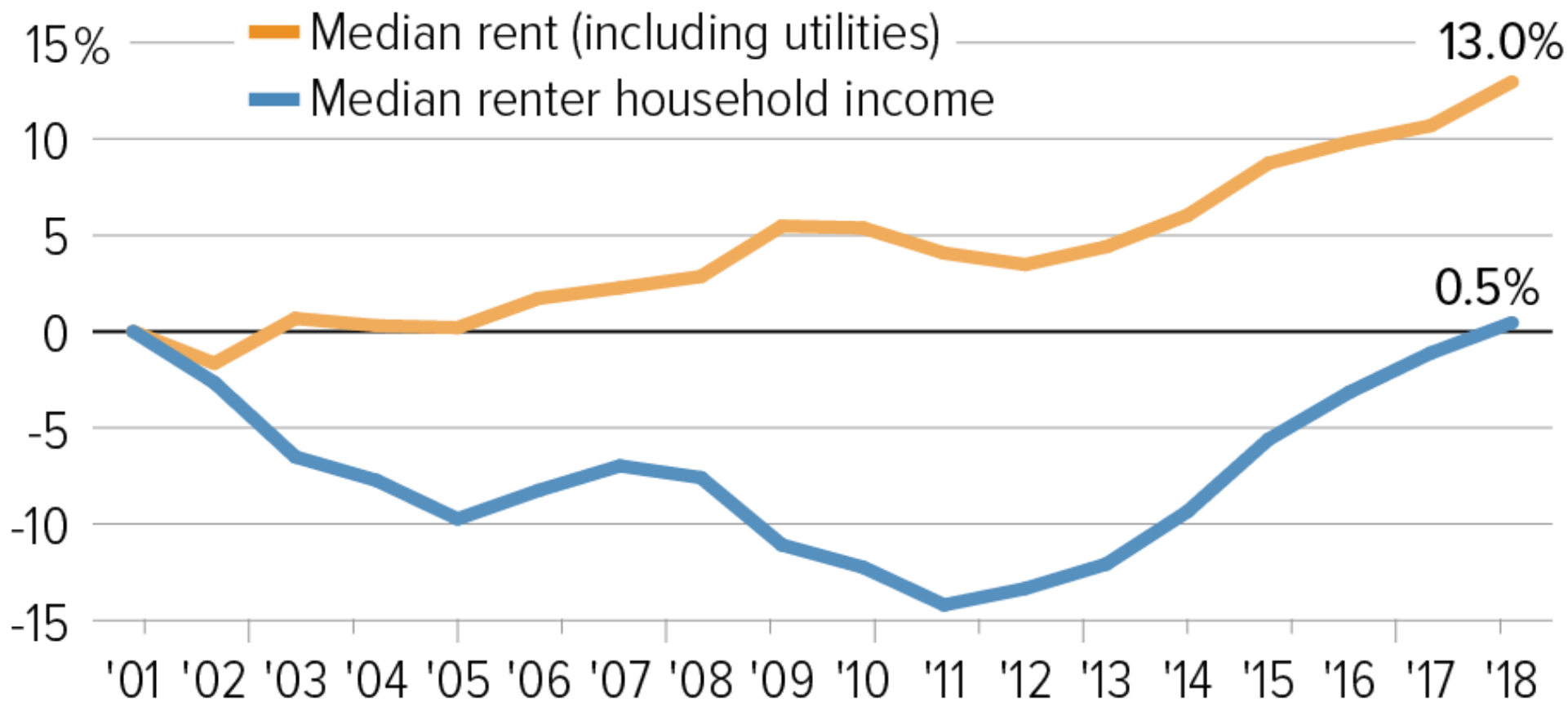

# Renters' Incomes Haven't Caught Up to Housing Costs

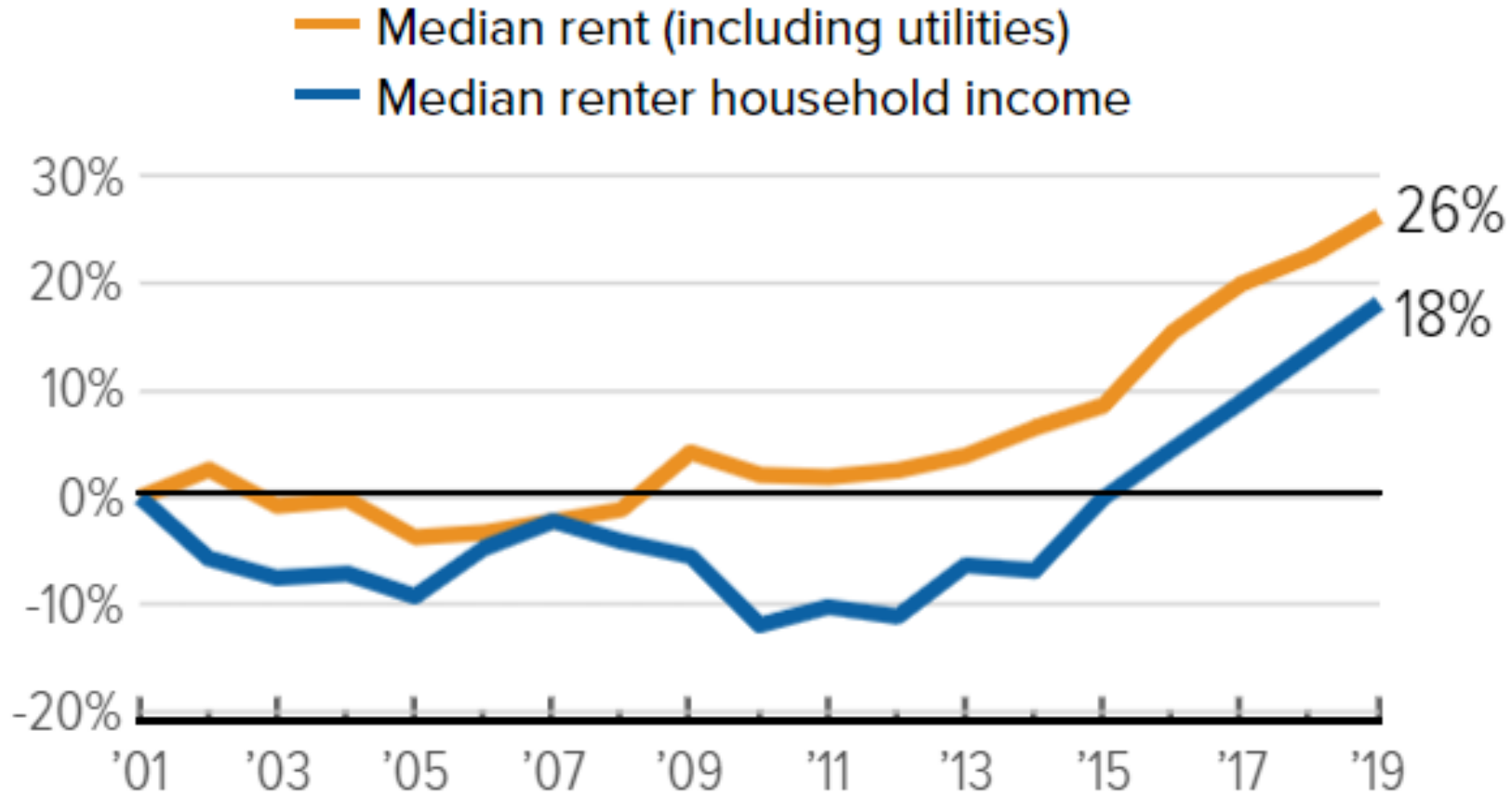
Percent change since 2001, adjusted for inflation

Percent change since 2001, adjusted for inflation



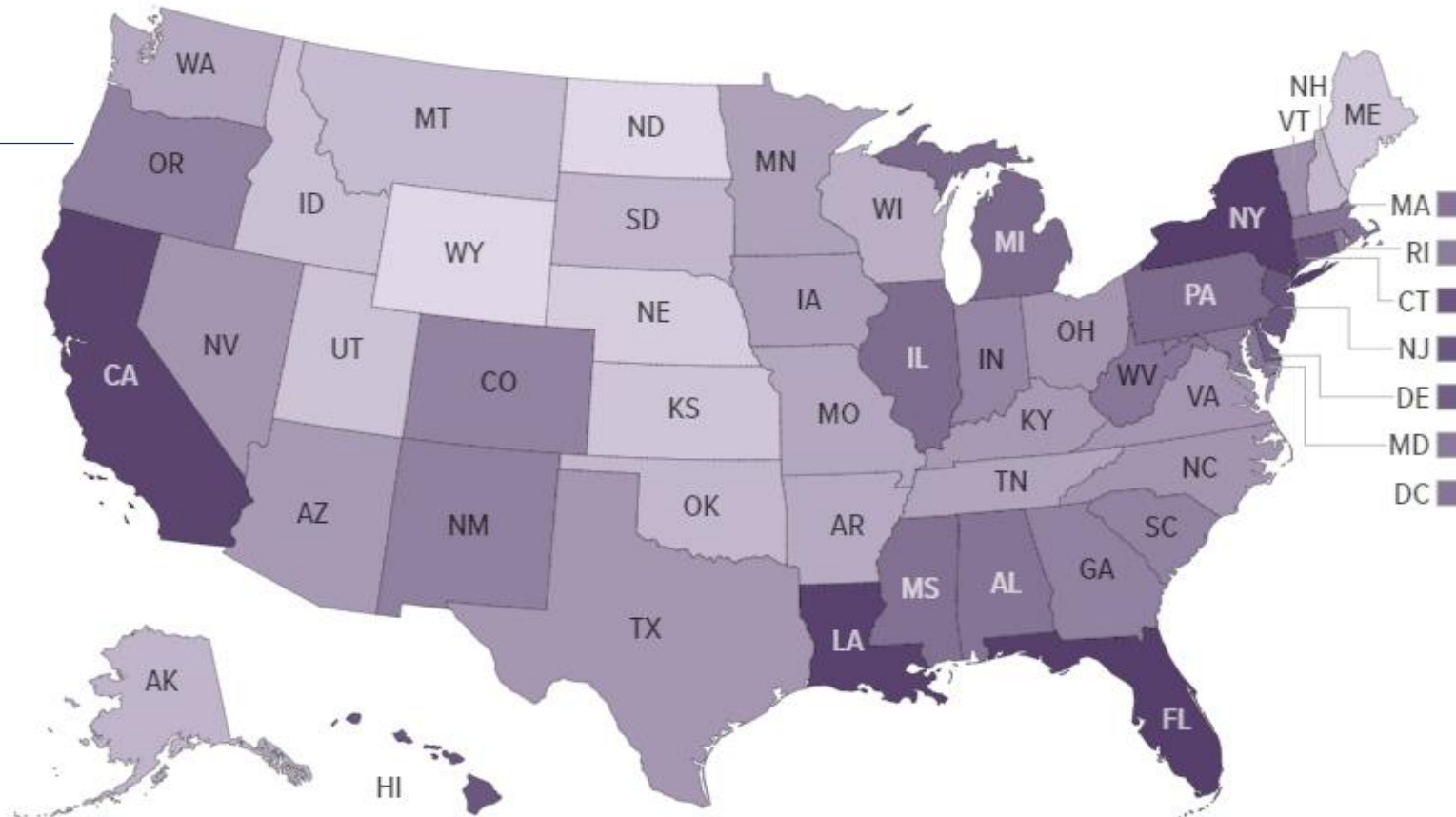

Share of adult renters in low-income households that pay over half their income for housing, by state

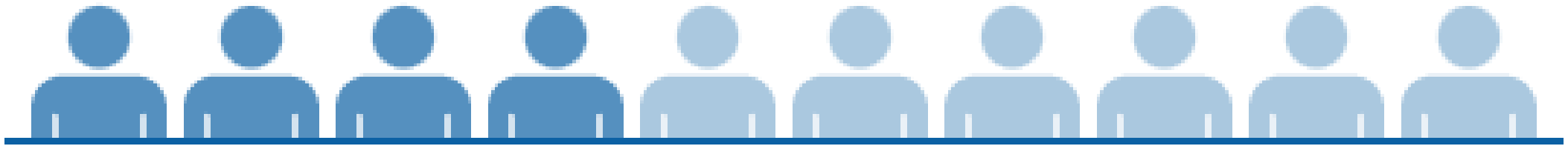

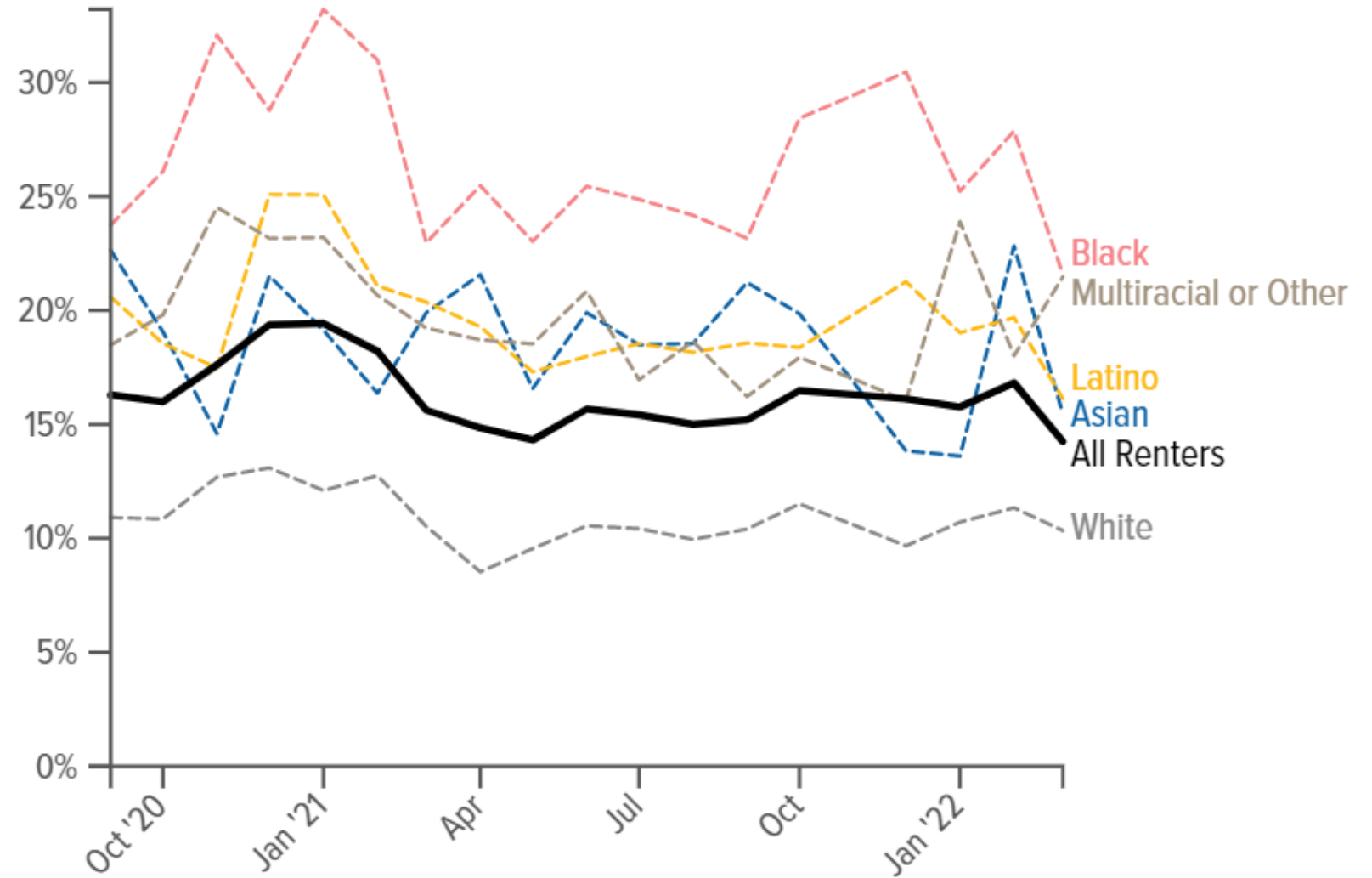

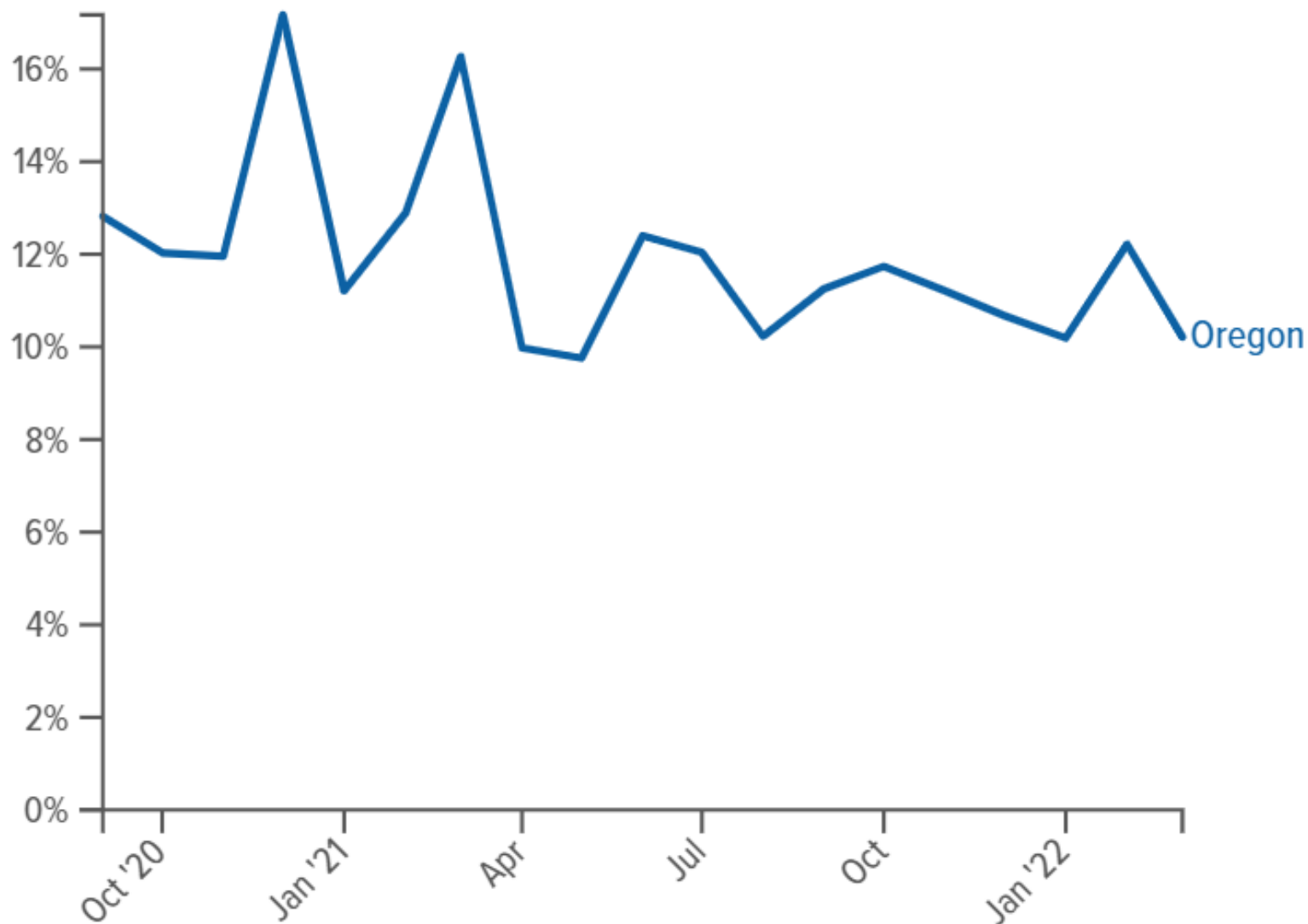
**Share of adult renters reporting that their household was not caught up on rent, by race**

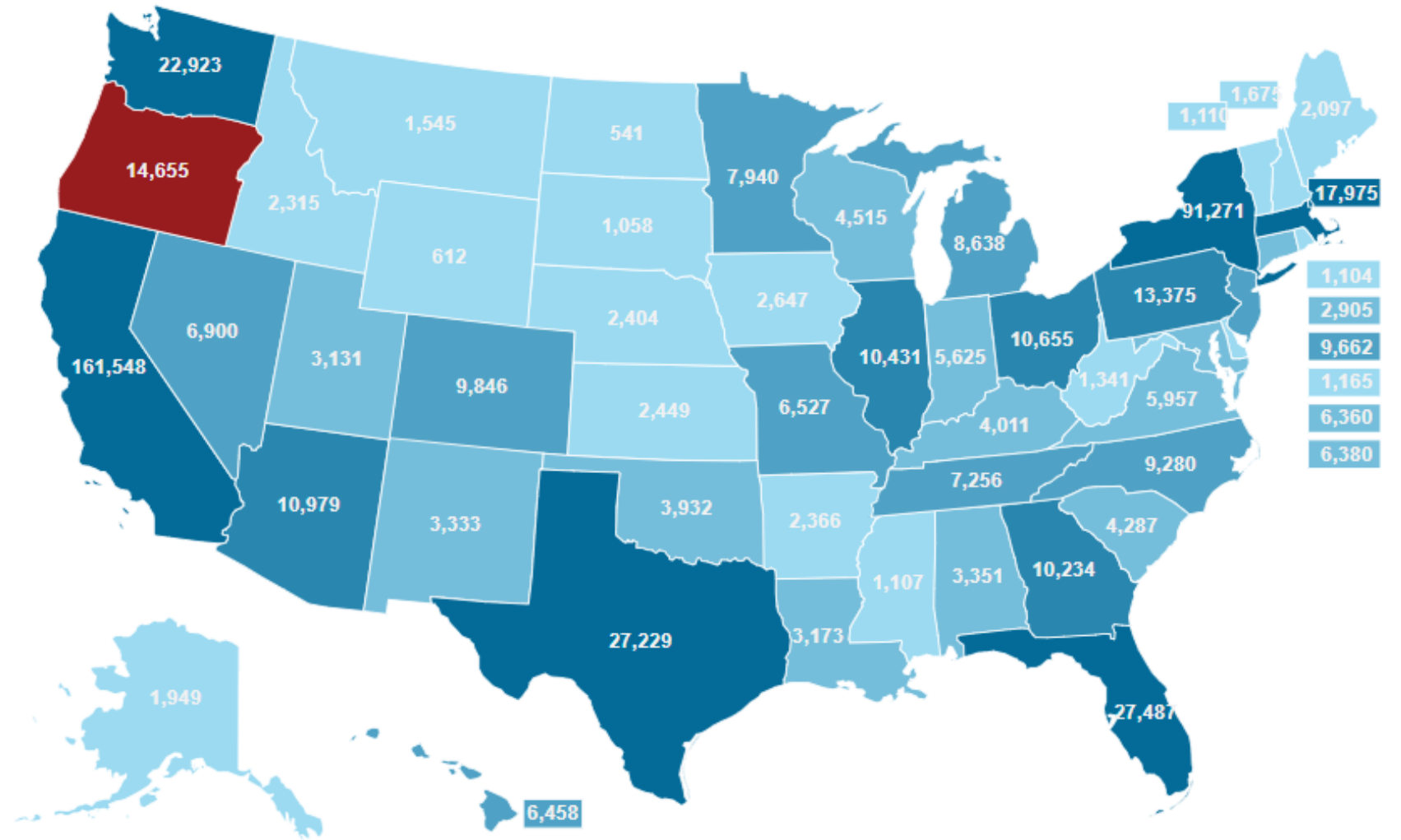
# SHARE OF ADULT OREGON RENTERS NOT CAUGHT UP ON RENT



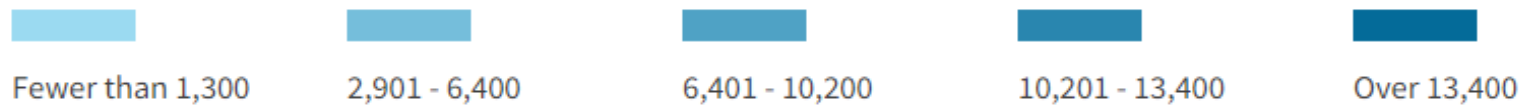

# NUMBER OF PEOPLE EXPERIENCING HOMELESSNESS ON A GIVEN NIGHT IN JANUARY 2020



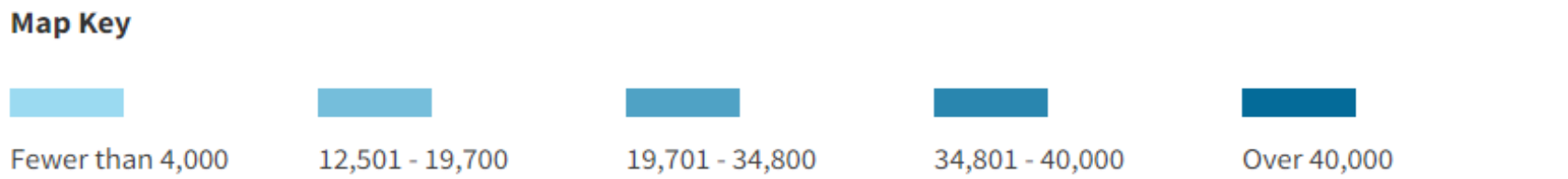
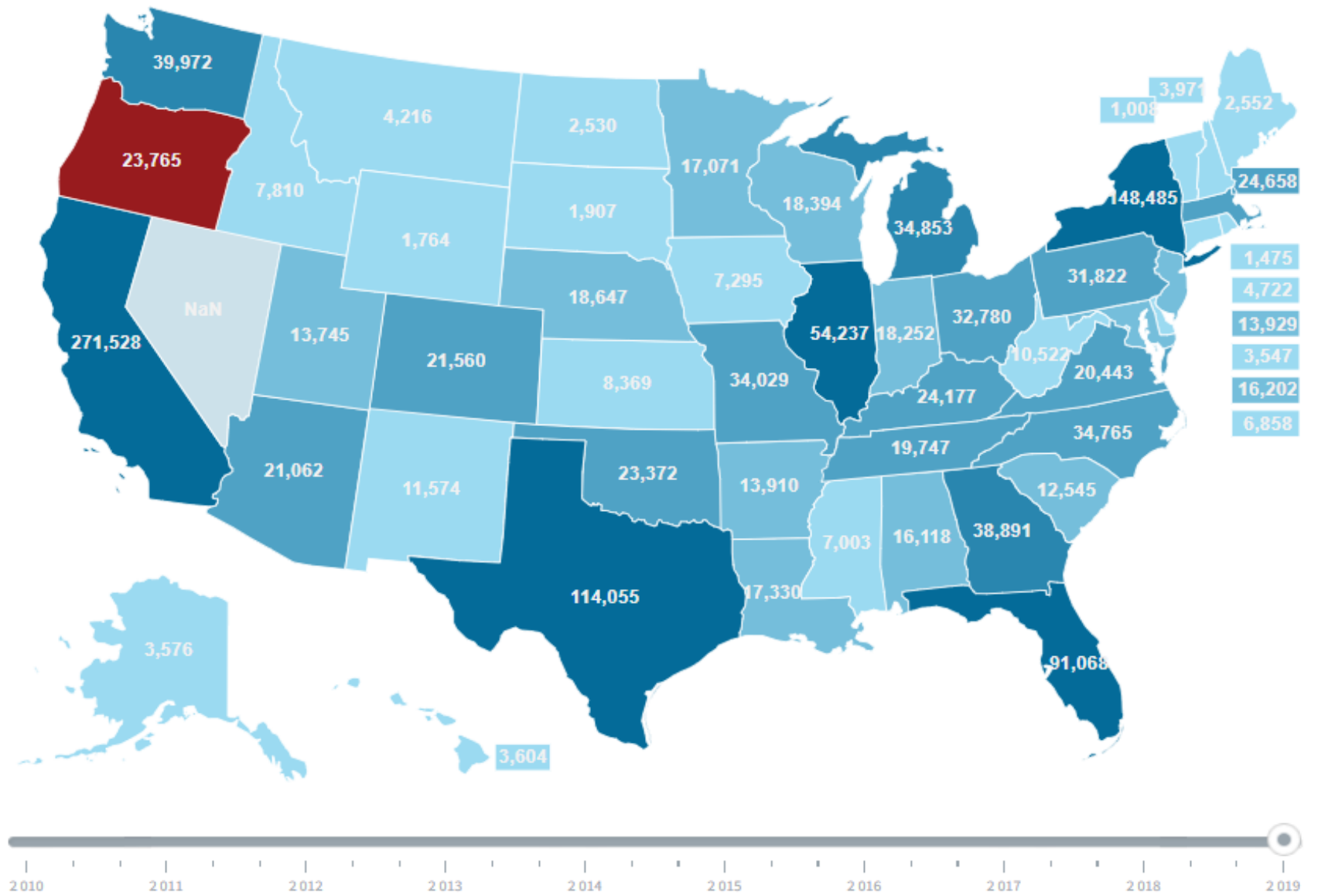
